### **Clinical Chemistry - Abbott Core Laboratory**

Clinical chemistry is the branch of laboratory medicine that focuses primarily on molecules The tests in a clinical chemistry laboratory measure concentrations of biologically important ions (salts and minerals), small organic molecules and large macromolecules (primarily proteins) See Section 6 for more detail about specific analytes

Reimbursement Methodology for Laboratory Services Most clinical diagnostic laboratory procedures performed in a physician's office, by an independent laboratory, or by a hospital laboratory for outpatients are reimbursed at the rate on the applicable IHCP Fee Schedule (professional or outpatient) or at the submitted charge, whichever is lower
